

## AUTOMATIC SWITCH OFF

Cruise control will switch off but the set speed will remain in the memory when:

- The **CANCEL** button (2) is pressed.
- The brake pedal is pressed.
- Speed falls below 30 km/h (18 mph).
- Neutral, Park or Reverse gear is selected.
- Dynamic Stability Control is operating.
- The difference between the actual and set speed is too great.
- When the vehicle reaches a maximum speed of 192 km/h (120 mph).
- The accelerator pedal is used to accelerate beyond the set speed for too long a period.

Cruise control will switch off and clear the memory when:

- The ignition system is switched off.
- A fault occurs. The cruise control system will switch off and cannot be used until the fault is cleared, contact your Dealer/Authorised Repairer.
