

2. Install the child restraint securely in the passenger seat and pass the tether straps over the seat in the positions shown (2).
3. Connect the tether straps to the tether anchorage point (3).
4. Tighten the tether straps according to the manufacturer's instructions.

BOOSTER SEATS

In a situation where a child is too large to fit into a child safety seat (child is over 20 lbs or 7.5 kg), but is still too small to safely fit the three point belt properly (under 4 feet 9 inches or 145 cm), a booster seat is recommended for maximum safety. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for fitting and use, then adjust the seat belt to suit.
