- 2. Install the child restraint securely in the passenger seat and pass the tether straps over the seat in the positions shown (2).
- **3.** Connect the tether straps to the tether anchorage point (**3**).
- **4.** Tighten the tether straps according to the manufacturer's instructions.

## **BOOSTER SEATS**

In a situation where a child is too large to fit into a child safety seat (child is over 20 lbs or 7.5 kg), but is still too small to safely fit the three point belt properly (under 4 feet 9 inches or 145 cm), a booster seat is recommended for maximum safety. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for fitting and use, then adjust the seat belt to suit.
