5. Front door stowage.
6. Stowage pockets on the rear of the front seats.
7. Rear door stowage.



Make sure any items stored in the vehicle are secure and cannot move. If the vehicle is involved in an accident, subject to sudden braking or a change of direction, loose items can cause serious injury.

AUXILIARY POWER SOCKETS

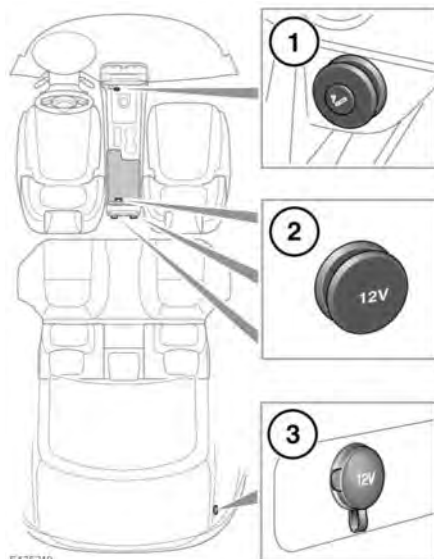


Only use approved accessories. Using any other equipment may damage the vehicle's electrical system and/or cause battery discharge. If you are in any doubt, contact a Retailer/Authorised Repairer.



The engine should be running when using accessories for long periods. Failure to do so can discharge the battery.

Note: Power sockets can be used to power approved accessories that use a maximum of 120 Watts.



1. Cigar lighter.
2. Power sockets, located in the front centre cubby box, and at the rear of the centre console.
3. Luggage compartment power socket.
